

## Christmas gift give-away with UCI

Thank you very much for wanting to partner with us in sharing the gospel with the children of our community! This is one of our favorite programs since it brings such joy to many people. I want everyone to know the costs that are involved. Please read the instructions carefully before committing to the program. If you decide not to participate, that is not a problem. Do what you are able to do. We appreciate all your help!

**Costs:** The gifts are placed in a 2-gal. ziplock bag and need to be shipped to our address:

These boxes may be shipped via USPS, UPS, Fed Ex, or hand-carried to this address. After the boxes are sent, you also need to send \$2.50/lb. to UCI for the international shipping and customs. This check should be made out to UCI with a note in the memo that states that it is for shipping/customs and your name or your organization's name. The check can be mailed to:

**Pictures:** Now that you know all the costs, you can decide if you would like to participate. The next step is to decide how many children you would like sponsor. I will take pictures of the children and send a link to a shared google photos album. I will have the name, gender and age of the child in the captions of the photoa. I encourage you to print 2 pictures—one to be placed facing outwards in the gift for the child and one for your refrigerator so that you can pray for the child during the season.

**Gifts:** Many people ask me what are good things to put into the gifts. I would like you to put a copy of the Christmas Story in each gift. I have this available in the link below. I have 3 different versions for you to choose. The kids also treasure a picture of your family, but this is only optional. The kids would appreciate anything you put in the gifts, but I noticed that a combination of practical (hygienic or school supplies or clothing) and fun gifts is a good choice. Here are some favorites—just a couple of ideas:

- \*Boys—soccer balls/air pumps, sunglasses, little cars, other balls, caps, wrapped food/candy,
- \*Girls—dolls with long hair, hair accessories, games, coloring books, wrapped food/candy

I will be sending pictures back to you of the children receiving their gifts. Please don't hesitate to ask me any other questions that you have.
